Please note: Dock assignments are based on membership seniority with boat size, safety and usage also considered. Wave runners cannot occupy deep water dock spaces
Second boat slips will be assigned by the Dock Master on a first come first serve basis after the Memorial Day weekend once all primary slips have been assigned. If you have a second slip you may have to move or remove your boat during the season if a member who doesn't have a primary boat needs a slip. In 2016 we had 26 deep water slips with 21 members' primary boats and three members' second boats.

If you plan to rent your house with a boat slip you must remove your boat and let your renter use your slip. If you do not have a boat slip and plan to rent your house with a boat slip, one will be assigned to you for the duration of the rental. If you have a second boat you must request a second slip. Please do not put a boat in a slip just because the slip appears to be available. It may have been assigned to another member who has not yet arrived.

Attention:

*If you have a 16 foot or smaller trailer boat/wave-runner and want to launch it from the Club launch you must be listed on the HOA launch agreement and only use the boat in Lake George. If you have a sunfish or similar boat without a motor that you don't trailer you can obtain a key for the launch from the dock committee.
